

Switch your primary financial institution to Sikorsky Credit Union in 4 easy steps.

Open an Account and Establish Membership

To establish membership, you'll need to put and maintain \$5.00 in a member savings account. You can <u>open your account online</u> or in person at one of our convenient <u>branch locations</u>.

Transfer Direct Deposit

Set up direct deposit to go right into one of your Sikorsky Credit Union accounts. <u>Click here</u> to print out our direct deposit form and hand it into your payroll provider. Go to page 2 for our full direct deposit check list.

Enroll in Online Banking

Manage your banking more conveniently by enrolling in online banking. You can <u>click here to get started online</u> or download our <u>Sikorsky Credit Union Mobile App</u> and get started there. Be sure to go paperless and enroll in eStatements!

Redirect Automatic Payments and Close Out Old Accounts

Transfer your automatic payments and ensure that any outstanding checks have cleared from your old account (See checklist on page 3 for help). After this step, close out your old accounts by calling your old bank or <u>completing this form</u> and sending it in to them.


