Pop-up scams are a form of online fraud where deceptive pop-up windows appear on your computer or device, often while browsing the internet. These pop-ups typically contain fake warnings or offers designed to trick users into providing personal information, installing malware, or making unnecessary purchases.

Here are some common types of pop-up scams to be aware of:

Tech Support Scams: Pop-ups claim that your computer has been infected with a virus or malware and urge you to call a provided phone number for assistance.

Fake Software Updates: Pop-ups mimic legitimate software update alerts, prompting you to download and install malicious software disguised as updates.

Phishing Scams: Pop-ups impersonate trusted companies or organizations, such as banks or government agencies, and ask for sensitive information like usernames, passwords, or credit card details.

Survey Scams: Pop-ups offer prizes or rewards in exchange for completing surveys or providing personal information.
